## Valid Immunization Certificates

during the 2021-2022 School Year:

**94.3%** had a Certificate of Immunization  
(fully vaccinated by law)

**2.3%** had a Religious Exemption

**0.3%** had a Medical Exemption

**1.9%** had a Provisional Certificate

**29,650** of students were under or un-immunized.

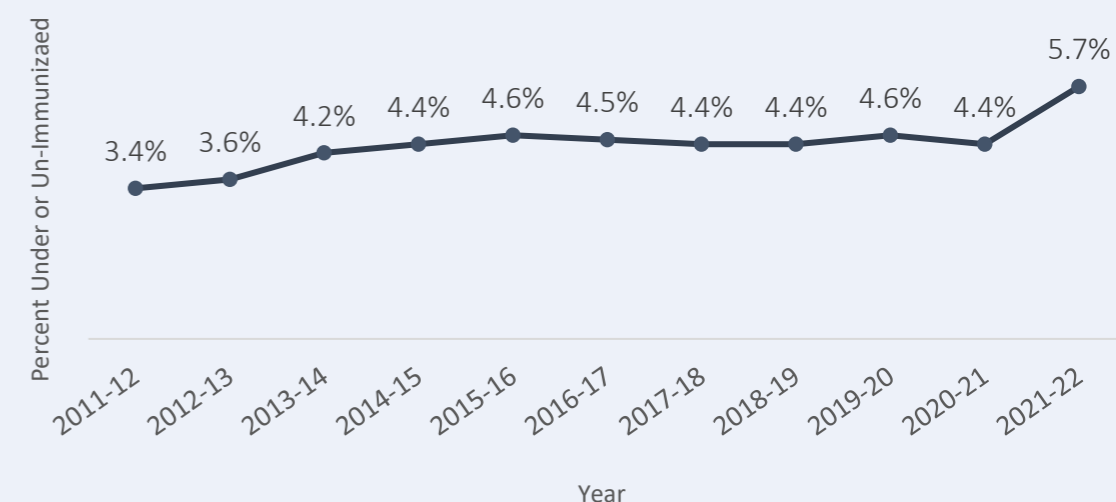

## Changes Over Time: Under or Un-Immunized Students

Percent of under or un-immunized students increased 1.3% from last year and has steadily been increasing since 2011.

It important to continue efforts in maintaining high vaccination rates in order to prevent the spread of vaccine-preventable diseases.

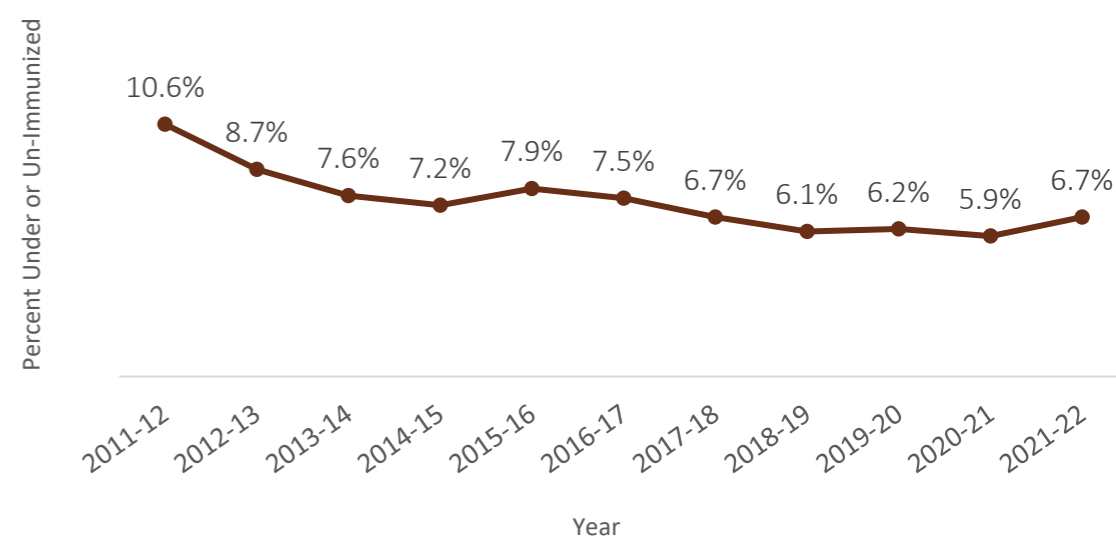

## Changes Over Time: Under or Un-Immunized Children

Although the percent of under or un-immunized children in licensed child care has steadily decreased over the last 10 years, there was a 0.8% increase from last year. These changes are most likely caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
