- Don't take lead home from the job





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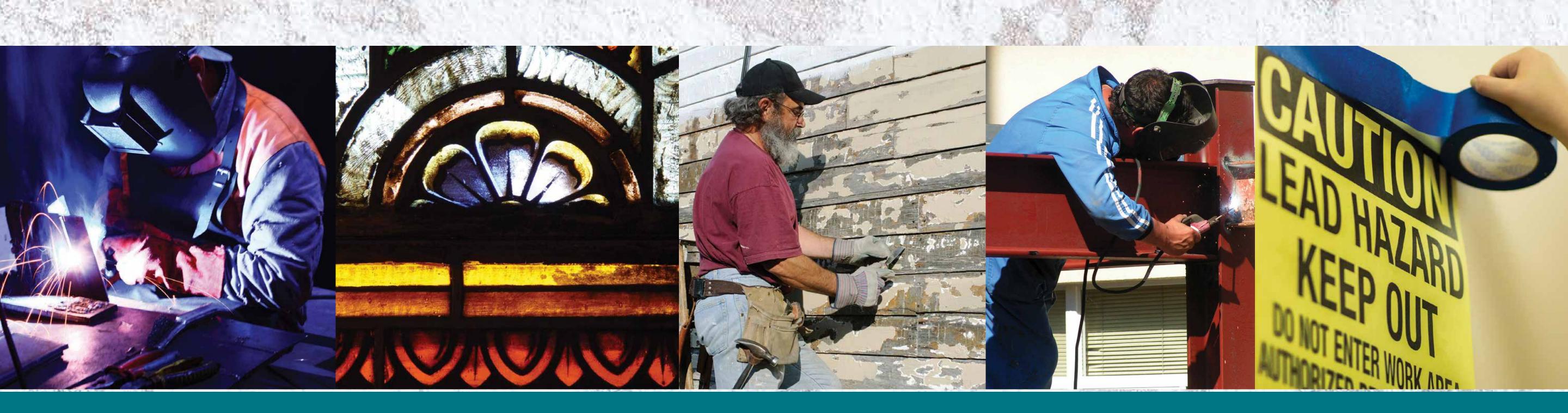

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Lead does NOT do a body good!

Some adult effects of lead poisoning include:

- Difficulties during pregnancy
- Reproductive problems for both men & women
- Cardiovascular & kidney problems
- Memory & concentration problems
- High blood pressure
- Digestive & nerve disorders
- Muscle & joint pain
- Glaucoma & anemia









Do you work around lead? Work Smart!

If you work with lead you could be bringing this toxic metal home on your:

- Clothes & shoes
- Skin, hair & hands

Take-home lead can cause lead poisoning in children and other family members.

Stop lead from getting into your home and vehicle by always washing, showering, and changing out of your work clothes and work shoes before leaving work.
