

Direct service provision must be implemented as follows:

- Seventy percent of direct service funding must be used to provide direct services to one of the following: those with serious mental illness; those with substance use disorders (SUDs), or those with co-occurring SMI and SUDs (50 clients);
- Ten percent of direct service funding must be used for healthcare practitioners with mental disorders (less severe than SMI) requiring mental health care as a result of COVID-19 (8 clients);
- Twenty percent of direct service funding must be used for all other individuals with mental disorders less severe than SMI (14).
