Assessment & Health Improvement Plan

- Required by IRS
- Covers hospital service area
- 3 year timeline

CHA CHIP

& Community Health & Community Health Improvement Plan

- To be used by the county and county stakeholders
- Covers entire county/ jurisdiction population
- 5 year timeline

Why change now?

- Align with local public health services (LPHS) contract timeline
- Create 5 year timeline to allow for new partnerships and collaborations
- Develop statewide standards
- Allow for broad dissemination of trainings and technical assistance

Deadline Requirements

2023 CHA CHIP reports

- Due Fall 2023 (state fiscal year 2024)
- Reports dated within last 3 years will be accepted
- New CHA CHIP requirements will <u>not</u> be required but are encouraged if not already completed

Community Health Assessment (CHA)

- One recommended CHA process with guide
- Stakeholder involvement required
- Assessment of the entire county population
- Primary data collection required
 - Community survey, focus groups, town halls
- Simple, easy to read report for the community
- Report available to public
 - o published to PH/county website, linked to IDPH site, or copies available by request
- May partner with surrounding counties to produce a joint CHA, all counties must actively participate in the entire process

Community Health Assessment (CHA)

Required report content:

- CHA Process: How did you conduct your assessment? What process did you use? What primary data did you collect?
- Community profile: Who lives in your county what are the demographics? What is the morbidity and mortality for the county? What disparities exist? What positively or negatively impacts the health of your community?
- Top issues: What were the top issues your community identified and why?

Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP)

- Stakeholder involvement required
- Calendar 5 schedule (i.e. January 2024 December 2028)
- Select up to 5 issues as priorities
- Simple easy to read report for the community
- Report available to public
 - o published to PH/county website, linked to IDPH site, or copies available by request
- Each jurisdiction produces an individual CHIP report

Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP)

Required report content:

- CHIP process: Who was involved? How was the community engaged?
 How were goals and strategies identified?
- Priorities, goals, objectives, and strategies: Identify your priorities and the goals, objectives, strategies, and responsible parties for each strategy.

Progress Reports

- Yearly
- Progress reports (Years 1 4)
 - o included in second quarter LPHS narrative report
 - what progress has been made, what successes have you seen, what challenges are you facing, what goals have changed
- Final progress Report (Year 5)
 - separate progress report tracking changes on each goal, objective, and strategy
 - what progress has been made, what challenges did you face
 - made available to the public

Resources: Data Packets

Each county will receive a packet of data with selected indicators

Data packets will include:

- Demographics of the county
- socioeconomic profile of the county
- health equity data
- indicators aligning with state health priorities

Resources: Templates

- Customizable optional templates for CHA and CHIP reports
 - Will include examples and explanations for recommended and required content
- Standard community survey

Resources: Technical Assistance & Trainings

- Health Assessments and Plans Coordinator to answer questions and provide individual technical assistance on CHA CHIP process to counties
- IDPH Bureau of Public Health Performance staff and Regional Community Health Consultant will provide support
- Webinars/training videos on variety of topics

Rollout of CHA CHIP Changes

- 2023 will be a pilot year
 - We want to meet your county where it is currently
- IDPH will work with counties not aligned with 2023 timeline to determine alignment
 - Have you started or finished your health assessment or improvement plan for the 2023 submission? Let me or your regional coordinator know the status of where you are at in the process for both.
