Announcements	Piper made the announcement that the director of the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH), Gerd Clabaugh, has accepted Governor Reynold's request that he serve as interim director of the Iowa Department of Human Services. He will continue to serve as the director of IDPH.	
New Committee Chair	Buckner Bentz introduced Amanda Devereaux as the new chair of this committee.	
Nomination/election of Vice Chair/Chair Elect	Piper – With Devereaux's move to committee chair, we need a new vice chair/chair elect. Nominations were requesting from members on the call, and none were received. Piper will add this to the agenda for the October 2019 meeting. In the meantime, please get any nominations to Piper and she will follow-up.	
SMA Pilot Update	Piper reviewed the SMA Pilot Summary presented to the State Board of Health on 7-10-19, and conveyed the Board of Health Chair's appreciation for the work of the Iowa Newborn Screening Program.	

Newborn Screening	Piper described the status of the requested NBS fee increase. After
Fee Increase	CIDAC approval of the fee increase, Piper presented the proposed budgets and justification for the fee increase to IDPH leadership. Piper met with the division director and answered questions she had at the time. The division director met with the department director and deputy director to review the budgets and requested fee increase. At that meeting, IDPH leadership decided to not take the fee increase request forward at that time, citing lack of justification to adequately support the proposed increase, and an unfavorable political climate for the approval of any fee increases.  Piper and the NBS program leadership revised the proposed budgets and justifications, and also wrote impact statements describing the impact to programming if the fee increase was not approved. These documents were forwarded to the interim division director, Jill Lange, and then to Director Gerd Clabaugh and Deputy Director Sarah Reisetter. The INSP leadership team has a meeting with Clabaugh and Reisetter, and the IDPH legislative liaison, Amy McCoy, on Monday July 22 to discuss the budgets and proposed fee increase.
