| Announcements | Piper announced that at the last CIDAC meeting (October 2019) members were to vote their approval for the use of developmental funds to support the SMA newborn screening pilot. Members voted online with unanimous approval. | |
| | Carol Johnson stated that a new genetic counselor (GC) has been hired. Georgianne Younger will provide backup support to the other NBS GCs, will provide telehealth counseling for newborns with a positive NBS (usually hemoglobinopathies, CF, SCID and CAH), and will contact families of newborns with a positive NBS 24 hours after the PCP has notified the parents of the results. | |
| | Devereaux asked about the status of the request for an increase in the newborn screening fee. Piper said that Director Clabaugh had requested revised budgets for his consideration, which the SHL has provided, but Clabaugh is now retiring as of July 31, so this | |
