Re: Vaccine Update: Hiberix Vaccine

Effective November 21, 2016, the Iowa VFC Program will allow providers to begin ordering Hiberix vaccine.

Hiberix is recommended as a 4-dose series given at ages 2, 4, 6, and 12-15 months of age. Hiberix, PedvaxHIB, Pentacel and ActHIB vaccines are interchangeable. If different brands of Hib vaccine are given at 2 and 4 months of age, a third dose of one of these brands should be administered at 6 months of age to complete the primary series. Any of these vaccine brands may be used for the booster dose, regardless of what brand of vaccine was administered in the primary series.

When placing an order for Hiberix vaccine, please review the clinic's vaccine inventory to identify all other vaccines needed. VFC providers should continue to place vaccine orders consistent with their economic order quantity (monthly, bimonthly or quarterly) and monitor existing Hib-containing inventory to ensure VFC vaccine is not wasted or allowed to expire.
