Testing Sites

The following agencies offer free and confidential HIV testing services to all Iowans.

- Rapid HCV screening is available at most sites to individuals who qualify.
- Immunizations for Hepatitis A & B are available at no-cost at most sites to individuals who qualify.
- Screening and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases are available at most sites – though there may be residency restrictions associated with certain agencies.

Each agency provides client assessment and counseling services to help determine an individual's risk for acquiring HIV. Referral to additional prevention services and linkage-to-care services for individuals who might test positive for HIV, are also available.

The Iowa Department of Public Health provides funding to local agencies to assist low-income, HIV-infected individuals with supportive services related to their health care needs. Client service providers are located throughout the state and provide information, referrals, HIV medication adherence assistance, and coordination between health partners. Iowans living with HIV should contact their nearest client services provider to determine if they qualify for help with an array of services including dental care, emergency financial assistance, food, health insurance premiums, co-pays, and deductibles, medical care, mental health counseling, substance abuse outpatient services, and transportation.

Ryan White HIV Clinical Services

The clinics below offer medical care for persons living with HIV/AIDS. They are funded through Part C of the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Extension Act of 2009. Physicians specializing in HIV care can also be found in private practice. Examples of clinic services (not all clinics offer all services listed) include HIV testing, HIV treatment, clinical trials, primary health care, CD4+ and viral load testing, immunizations, TB testing, pap smears, nutritional counseling, referrals to other specialty care, case management, mental health services, substance abuse treatment, and oral health care.


