RE: Vaccine Shortage Order

Effective immediately, the Vaccine Shortage Orders issued by the Iowa Department of Public Health on December 14, 2020, January 21, 2021, February 1, 2021, and March 08, 2021 have been rescinded.

Effective April 05, 2021, any person age 16 or 18 and over (as defined by the respective vaccine Emergency Use Authorization) is eligible to receive a vaccination from enrolled COVID-19 Vaccine Providers. Enrolled vaccine providers may reference the "Iowa Department of Public Health COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Policy" dated April 05, 2021 for guidance regarding prioritization needs as well as immunity protections while providing medical care in response to the public health disaster.
