Instructions to Staff:

If the participant answers "no" to all questions a face to face meeting may be held if they also do not have an elevated temperature. Store the completed health screening record in the participant file with other confidential and sensitive documents.

If the participant answers "yes" to any question no face to face meetings shall be held. A supervisor must approve a subsequent face to face meeting after a positive health screen.

YES response to question one. No face to face meetings shall be held until the participant or household member have a minimum of 21 days without these symptoms.

YES response to question two. No face to face meetings shall be held until the participant or household member have received a negative response from their COVID-19 test.

YES response to question three. No face to face meetings shall be held until the participant or household member has been returned from travel for a minimum of 21 days.

YES response to question four. No face to face meetings shall be held until the participant or household member has been tested negative for COVID-19 or a minimum of 21 days post exposure has passed.

Temperature higher than 100.4 degrees for any family member will result in meeting via video conference or telephone. The participant or family member with an elevated temperature shall have at least 72 hours without an elevated temperature before a face to face meeting will be considered along with a health screening with all negative responses.
