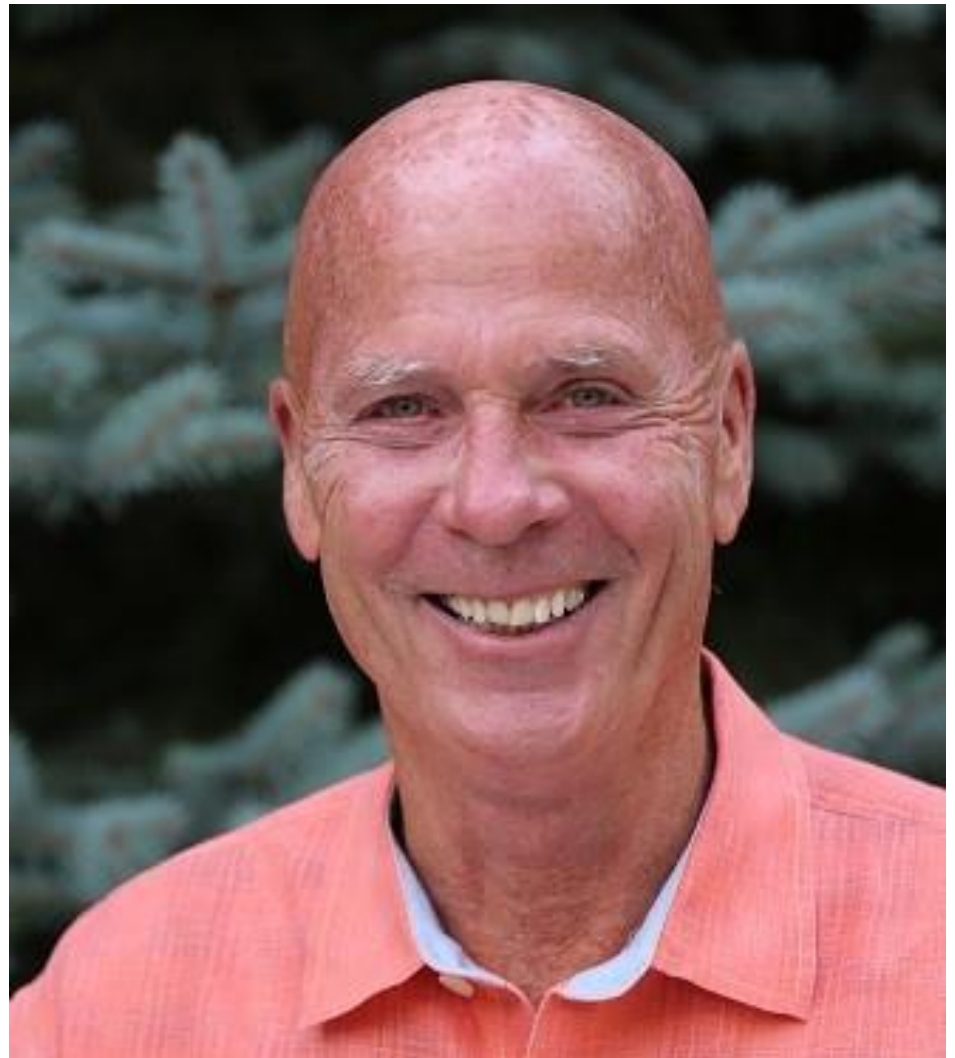
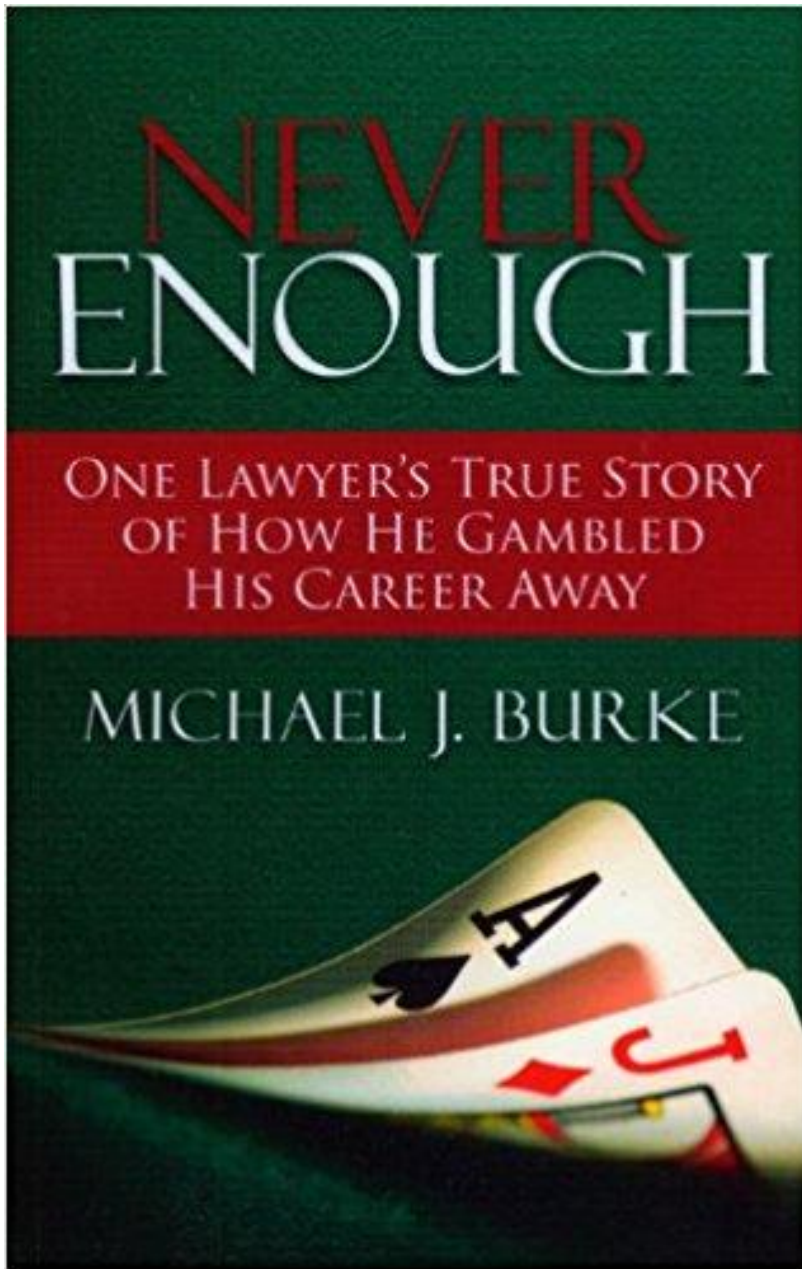
Looking to the Horizon: *Trends in Problem Gambling Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery Services*

Michael J. Burke, JD, is the Executive Director of the Michigan Association on Problem Gambling.

He is in recovery from alcoholism for 39 years and recovery from gambling for 16 years. He was a lawyer in a small community for 25 years before he was disbarred in 2001 because of embezzlement of clients funds to feed his gambling addiction. As a direct result of that activity he served three years in prison and was ordered to repay to his victims the sum of 1.6 million dollars.

Upon returning home he wrote a book about his addiction which has been published by the American Bar Association. The name of the book is *Never Enough: One Lawyer's True Story Of How He Gambled His Career Away*. Proceeds from the book go to his victims.

Today he travels around the U.S. giving talks on gambling and has spoken in over 40 states.
